After you finish reading *Ralph S. Mouse* by Beverly Cleary, please choose one of the following projects to present to our class during the first couple weeks of school. Please feel free to be as creative as you want...this is your way to "celebrate" the book.

- ~ Write a sequel to the story.
 - This may be typed or written in cursive and must be at least 200 words.
- ~ Create a board game based on the book.
 - Make the actual board and game pieces to play!
- ~ Design a new cover for the book.
 - Must be the actual size of the book, and include the title and author's name.
- ~ Create a timeline of the story.
 - May be typed or written in cursive. It can include drawings in addition to text.
- ~ An interview with a character in the book.
 - Questions / Answers may be typed or written in cursive. At least 7 questions and only 1 "yes / no" question.
- ~ Write 7 diary entries of a character.
 - Choose 1 character and date entries. Write that character's thought and feelings.
