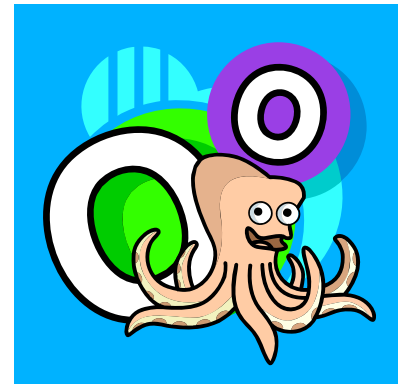


April 28, 2008
